Born and raised in Hanley, Sask., Ken King was the vice-chairman and chief executive officer of Calgary Sports and Entertainment Corporation.

Ken was an active member of the Calgary community, always displaying exemplary leadership and an enthusiastic commitment to amateur and professional sport. He was involved with several organizations including the TELUS Community Board, the Calgary Sport Tourism Authority, Director of the Calgary Airport Authority and he is a former chairman of the Calgary Chamber of Commerce, while leading the Calgary Flames Foundation and Stampeders Football Foundation.

In Ken’s honour, the Ken King Community Award will be granted to athletes in the Calgary community who reflect this through their commitment to positively impacting their community, something that Ken always strived to achieve.

All applicants **MUST** have received KidSport Calgary Funding or Calgary Flames Sports Bank Assistance within the last calendar year, be between the ages of **10-18 years**, and will be required to complete this application form. Application deadlines are July 30th and October 30th. Please allow 4 weeks after the deadline for the committee to review the application.

 - A) How you (the participant) are striving to have a positive impact on the community and what volunteer work you are involved in (250-500 words)
 - B) What being involved in sport means to you (250 words)
 - C) One impactful experience you have had through your involvement in sports (250 words)

Ken King Community Award FAQ's

- When can I apply?
 - o Application deadlines are July 30th and October 30th each year. Applications period will open June 1st and September 1st each year.

- What ages can apply?
 - o The applicant must be between the ages of 10-18 years old.

- How much funding can you expect to receive?
 - o Chosen recipients can receive up to \$1,000 in funding to further their sport and athletic pursuits.
 - Funds will be directed to the sport club, program, or retailer to support the approved expenses.

- What can the funding be used for?
 - o Funding will be directed to furthering the recipient's sporting pursuits. These dollars can be used for coaching, training, registration fees or approved equipment.

- Does an applicant have to be a KidSport Calgary or Calgary Flames Sports Bank recipient?
 - o Yes, all applicants must have received funding from KidSport Calgary & Area or equipment support from the Flames Sports Bank within the last calendar year.

- When can I expect to hear about the status of my application?
 - o All applicants will be informed of the final committee decision on their application 4 weeks after the deadline.
 - o Please do not contact our office requesting a status update as it will not be provided.

- Will I be notified if my application is not accepted?
 - o All selected and rejected applicants will be informed of the status of their application once the final decisions have been made.

- Can I receive the Ken King Community Award more than once?
 - o No, once you have been selected as a recipient of the award, you are not eligible to receive it again.
