


So ALL Kids Can Play!

KidSport believes in the power of sport to contribute to healthy communities, while fostering leaders of tomorrow.



HISTORIC SUMMER FOR KIDSPORT SASKATCHEWAN

On June 13, KidSport Saskatchewan launched a local KidSport chapter on James Smith Cree Nation. This marks the first chapter on a First Nation in Canada!



The chapter was launched thanks to Canadian Sport For All funding through Sport Canada. KidSport Saskatchewan recognized that the community had a number of applications from the area and thought it would be a strong location for a chapter.

During the celebration, approximately 150 students heard directly from Brett Lachance of James Smith Cree Nation on the positive influence sport has had on his life.
