How KidSport helps:

- KidSport subsidizes sport registration fees for local children from eligible families. This is done through a qualifying application process.
- Eligible Edmonton-based families may receive:
 - **'So ALL Kids Can Play!' Grant Funding** - Up to a maximum of **\$300 per child per calendar year** (Jan. 1 – Dec. 4, 2026) for most sports; and/or
 - **Hockey Assist Program (HAP) Grant Funding** - Up to a maximum of **\$750 per child per hockey season** (May 1, 2025 – April 30, 2026) for *Hockey Edmonton sanctioned ice hockey programs* including Elite, House, Recreation, Para hockey and Learn to Play Hockey.

Who Can Apply:

- If your family lives within the City of Edmonton
- If your family meets the financial eligibility requirement
- If your child is 18 years old or younger
- If your child is registered in an eligible sport program
- If you apply before the sport program ends

How to Apply:

- Register your child in a sport program
- Complete a KidSport Edmonton application via **one** of the following methods:
 - **Paper Application:** Can be submitted by email, fax, mail, or dropped off at the KidSport Edmonton office.
 - **Online or Paper Application Webform:** Visit our website and select "Apply for a Grant".
- Include **both required documents** when submitting the application
 - Sport Registration Receipt** showing:
 - Your Child's Full Name
 - Sports Club Name
 - Sport Program's Start and End Dates
 - Total Registration Costs
 - Financial Documentation** (*one of the following*):
 - Canada Child Benefit Notice (*Must be from most recent tax year*)
 - City of Edmonton Leisure Access Program (LAP) Registration Letter (*Must include expiry dates*)

*Please note:

- One application per child, per sport
- Notify the sport organization that you have submitted your KidSport Edmonton Application for grant funding
- KidSport Edmonton will confirm the application status result via email, typically within 4 weeks of receiving it
- Approved grant funding is sent directly to the Sport Club. The Sport Club will reimburse the Parent/Guardian who paid for the sport program. Families are responsible for any remaining fees.
- The Parent/Guardian who registers their child and is listed on the Sport Registration Receipt **must be the same** Parent/Guardian who applies for KidSport funding
- Incomplete application or illegible paper applications will delay processing. KidSport Edmonton emails the Parent/Guardian about missing information required to process their application. Applications can be declined if missing information is sent after the end date of sport program.
