The LAP Annual Program: What's included?

Free, unlimited admission to City of Edmonton-operated Recreation and Leisure Centres, as well as attractions such as the Edmonton Valley Zoo, Fort Edmonton Park, and the Muttart Conservatory, for the listed term.

Instructor-led drop-in classes such as Aquafit, Yoga, Spin Bike Classes, Strollercize, and many more.

Access to the drop-in Child Minding service at Clareview, Commonwealth, Kinsmen, The Meadows, and Terwilligar recreation centres. Children must have an active Leisure Access Program membership to access Child Minding.

Access to one bucket of balls per day at Victoria Driving Range. *Golf club rentals are not included*

Access to the Youth in Action program for youth aged 12 - 15 years.

Access to drop-in Shiny and Member Skate.

A **75% discount on Registered Programs**. Adults receive 3 discounts per year and children/youth receive 4 (some exceptions may apply in which this discount is not available). To apply these discounts, program registrations may be booked by calling 311, online via your MoveLearnPlay account, or in person at the recreation facilities and attractions.

For example, each of the following options is equivalent to one registered program:

- One round of golf, whether 9 holes or 18 holes. Tee times must be booked in advance.
- One Camp registration for participating Day Camps.
- One registered Swimming Lesson Course at the City of Edmonton Recreation Centres.

Please note: the Terwilligar Club Membership (and its amenities) are **not included** in these programs. Personal Training, either 1on1 or group; exercise consultations; and nutrition services are also **not included** in the Leisure Access Program benefits.

Please note: The Leisure Access approval is non-transferable and Leisure Access Memberships will not be extended.

The Ride Transit Program: What's included?

Those approved for the Ride Transit Program can receive a subsidized Ride Transit Fare Product for **\$36.00**.

These subsidized fare products are available through the Arc electronic fare payment system. Arc may also be used on Dedicated Accessible Transit Service (DATS) for registered DATS clients.

Each participant can only receive or use one subsidized fare product at any given time.

The fare products are non-transferable and must only be used by the registered Ride Transit Program participant. Misuse Arc cards may result in removal from the Ride Transit Program. If you lose an Arc card, please contact the Arc Call Centre at 1-888-302-0001.



How to access your **Canada Child Benefit (CCB)** Notice

1. [Log into CRA My Account](#) from a desktop computer (*PDFs may not generate properly if logged in from a mobile device*)
2. Click **Mail** 
3. Scroll down on the left side to **Correspondence**
4. Look for your **most recent CCB notice (base year 2024)** and click "**Open**". 
5. Click "**PDF**".  Click "**Print/Save**".
6. This will generate your **CCB Notice as a PDF** to download and save a copy to your computer.
7. Either **attach the CCB Notice** to your *online* or *webform* KidSport Edmonton grant application or attach it to an email and send with your completed *paper* application and sport receipt to edmonton@kidsport.ab.ca.
