

The 5th Annual Jason Gregor Pizza Pigout presented by Swift was one for the books!

Over 300 KidSport (and pizza) supporters got together on October 11 to chow down on delicious 'zza all while creating equal access to sport for KidSport kids through purchasing tickets, being a corporate partner, and participating in the 50/50 and the Pizza Box Raffle.

This year, 20 Pizzerias participated by donating their dough, to help KidSport raise some dough, which equated to 386 pizza boxes placed on the glorious pizza buffet, totalling at least 3,088 pizza slices. Don't worry, everyone was encouraged to wear their stretchy pants to fully max out on this experience! The best part was that \$43,500 net was raised for KidSport. This subsidizes sport registration fees for 175 KidSport kids, enabling access for them to participate in their favourite sport programs from soccer to martial arts and dance.
