The LAP Annual Program: What's included?

Unlimited admission to City of Edmonton operated Recreation and Leisure Centres, as well as attractions such as the Edmonton Valley Zoo, Fort Edmonton Park, and the Muttart Conservatory for the listed term.

Instructor-led drop-in classes such as Aquafit, Yoga, Spin Bike Classes, Strollercize and many more. Please note that the Terwillegar Club Membership (and its amenities) are not included in these programs.

Access to the drop-in Child Minding service at Clareview, Commonwealth, Kinsmen, The Meadows, and Terwillegar recreation centres.

Access to one bucket of balls per day at Victoria Driving Range.

Access to the Youth in Action program for youth aged 12 - 15 years.

Access to drop-in Shinny and Member Skate.

The Waste Services Reuse Centre (6835 83 St NW) reopened in January, and to celebrate their 15th anniversary they have removed all fees for 2022. This circular economy resource accepts over 200 unique household items from residents and makes them available to organizations and individuals for reuse.

A 75% discount on Registered Programs, with adults receiving 3 discounts per year and children/youth receiving 4. (Some exceptions may apply in which this discount is not available). To apply these discounts, program registrations may be booked by calling 311, or in person at the recreation facilities and attractions. Registered programs are not available at Scona Pool.

For example, each of the following options is equivalent to one registered program:

One round of golf, whether 9 holes or 18 holes. Tee times must be booked in advance.

One Reuse Centre workshop.

One registered Swimming Lesson Course at the City of Edmonton Recreation Centers.

Please note: The Leisure Access approval is non-transferable and Leisure Access Memberships will not be extended.

The Ride Transit Program: What's included?

Those approved for the Ride Transit Program are able to purchase a subsidized Ride Transit Monthly Pass at a cost of \$35.00.

ETS monthly passes are valid for use from the 1st day of the month until the last day of the month indicated on the pass and allow unlimited travel on regular ETS buses and LRT services. Passes may also be used on Dedicated Accessible Transit Service (DATS) if you are a registered DATS client.

Only one monthly pass at the subsidized rate will be permitted per participant per month and are available only in Adult or Youth passes.

ETS monthly passes purchased at the subsidized rate are non-transferable and intended for use by the registered Ride Transit Program participant only. ETS does not replace lost or stolen passes.

What is NOT included in the program?

The Ride Transit Program and qualifying to purchase the ETS Ride Transit monthly bus pass may not be included due to one of the following non-qualifiers for one or more applicants:

Accessing the Recreation and Leisure Facilities, Attractions, and other benefits of the LAP Annual Program:

Please bring your Welcome Letter to any participating City of Edmonton recreation facility or attraction (excluding Fort Edmonton Park) along with a **Government Issued Photo ID**. Each approved applicant will have their photo taken and a membership card issued. Photo ID is required for each adult on the account in order to access the account until the membership card is printed.

If you and/or other members of the household already have membership cards then this may not be required. However, if an updated picture is required, the facility will be able to do so at no charge. A \$5.00 administration fee will be charged for replacement of lost or stolen passes.
