A MESSAGE FROM OUR LEADERSHIP

2024 was a year of remarkable growth and success for KidSport Wood Buffalo, marked by increased impact, community engagement, and financial sustainability.

Relative to last year, we nearly doubled our reach and proudly supported **582 young athletes**, distributing just over **\$159K in funding**, breaking barriers to sport participation across our region. A key focus was improving our reach to underserved demographics, including Indigenous youth, female athletes, and those requiring adaptive sports. Through targeted community engagement, we strengthened partnerships and removed financial barriers for even more children.

Our commitment to long-term sustainability saw the continued success of our **signature fundraising events**, including the **Pizza Pig Out, FAM Expo, and Cash Calendars** to name only a few. These initiatives, along with some new and unique fundraising events generated vital revenue and deepened our connection within the community.

We recognize and thank so many community groups for their unwavering support, collaborating on our fundraising events, generous **corporate donors** and **grant funds** instrumental in making our program possible. 



OUR DEMOGRAPHICS



KidSport Wood Buffalo continues to prioritize diversity and inclusion in sport by implementing strategies to increase the representation of underserved demographics in the region.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

PIZZA PIGOUT

Adapted from KidSport chapters in Edmonton and Calgary, KidSport Wood Buffalo brought the Pizza Pigout to Fort McMurray for the second year, raising crucial funds for the organization.

The event featured all-you-can-eat pizza as well as a pizza-eating contest, a guest host, local guest celebrities, specialty drink stations, a pizza box raffle, prizes and more. Local pizzerias brought their best creations to compete for the community awarded the 'Best Pizza' award with Milano's bringing home the title for the second year in a row. With over 100 guests in attendance, the Pizza Pigout 2024 was a huge success.



FAM EXPO

For the second consecutive year, KidSport Wood Buffalo held our second annual family friendly Mini Comicon at Shell Place. The event offered a Kidzone full of activities for the kids, a large Vendor Showcase with locally made and sourced merchandise, an ESport Station, specially selected Panelists, a Cosplay Show on the Red Carpet, Food Trucks, etc.



CASH CALENDARS

KidSport Wood Buffalo initiated a spring Cash Calendar fundraiser with draws made daily throughout the month of May. Each entry earned participants 23 chances to win cash prizes.



HOCKEY ASSIST PROGRAM

The Edmonton Oilers Community Foundation has invested \$1.5M to continue the KidSport Oil Country Hockey Assist Program (HAP) for the third straight year! The HAP program is dedicated to increasing access to youth hockey across Oil Country!

Approved applicants are eligible to receive up to \$750 per player for their registration fees, as well as access to no-cost equipment from Sport Central.

In 2024 the HAP provided 36 kids from Wood Buffalo access to hockey throughout the year.



EVERY KID CAN PLAY

In 2023, the Government of Alberta launched the Every Kid Can Play Program, further to the success of their previous Return to Play Program. In doing so, they committed \$3,610,150 to KidSport Alberta to promote equal play across the province of Alberta by providing subsidies for program registration costs to help children and youth whose families require financial assistance to access sport, physical activity, and recreation. These funds enabled us to provide direct financial support to more than 12,229 children by distributing up to \$350 per child registration to eligible families.

During a record-breaking 2024, KidSport Alberta chapters supported more kids into sport programs than ever before and we would not have been able to do this without the incredible support of the Every Kid Can Play Program.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR TREASURER

I am pleased to present the Treasurer's Report for KidSport Wood Buffalo for the 2024 financial year.

This year, we were fortunate to receive approximately \$327,000 in donations from a variety of sources, including corporate donors, grants, fundraising events, sponsorships, and investment returns. The Board and Executive Director are proud to report that over \$160,000 has been allocated directly to the community, ensuring that all children have the opportunity to participate in sports. Our total administrative and operating expenses for the year increased from 2023, reaching \$347,000. Despite this, our cash balance remains strong, and we have sufficient reserves to cover our operational needs.

As of the end of 2024, KidSport Wood Buffalo has supported over 2,700 children, with a total of \$1.2 million invested since 2010. This is a remarkable milestone for our organization, and the Board takes great pride in being a part of this achievement.

In closing, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to our donors, volunteers, and supporters. Your ongoing commitment is what allows KidSport Wood Buffalo to continue empowering children through sports. With your continued support, we remain dedicated to ensuring we do our part to reduce financial barriers so that more children have an opportunity to participate in sports.
